MATC Dental Assistant Class

This program trains you to perform chairside assisting and related office and laboratory procedures under the supervision of a dentist. You will learn how to identify and use dental equipment, expose and process dental radiographs, and respond to dental emergencies and perform basic office procedures.

Phlebotomist/ Specimen Processor:

Apprenticeships

Biotechnology Lab Support Assistant Apprentice: This is a one-year apprenticeship training with classroom instruction. This program teaches you the background knowledge to perform entry level support tasks including maintain a clean and sterile work environment, collaborative teams, making solutions, and maintaining proper documentation. Apprentices receive financial aid from employers and receive an hourly wage during training and any classroom instruction.

Average starting salary: \$15-20 per hour

Bricklaying/ Masonry Apprentice: This is a three-year apprenticeship program where you will build walls and structures using bricks, concrete blocks, and mortar. The work varies in complexity from laying a walkway to installing an ornate exterior on a high-rise building. This program and career require kneeling, bending, and lifting of heavy materials, so physical ability should be a serious consideration for this program. Apprentices are sponsored through employers and receive an hourly wage during their instruction.

Cosmetology Apprentice: This four-semester program is designed to give you real world experience working in a salon and attend school.
