You may have a prescription for medicine you know you need but haven't been able to afford. Maybe you've taken that medication only when you felt sick. Perhaps you're waiting to become eligible for health insurance coverage. We may be able to help you. This is why we operate the St. Vincent de Paul Charitable Pharmacy.

Who Is Eligible

To receive free medications and services through the program, you must:

- Already have a valid prescription from pharmacy first or any appropriate healthcare provider
- Have no prescription drug coverage, including Medicare Part D plans
- Meet the household-income guideline, 200% of the federal poverty level guideline or lower (See information about this on another organization's website here)
- Confirm Dane County residency

How to Apply

- **By doing the following, you will need to certify for the program at our Service Center (2033 Fish Hatchery Road in Madison) at some point Monday through Friday between 1:00 and 3:30 p.m.:**
- **Fill out an initial form with an intake receptionist**
- **Complete a more-detailed application, which will require proof of claimed income. Bring the following documents with you:**
 - Photo ID
 - Proof of Dane County residency (a bill, lease, current check stub or photo ID with address)

If you claim any income, verification of household income (of all household members), including any of the following that pertain:

- **Two most-recent paychecks or pay stubs**
- **Unemployment benefit statement**
- **Social Security, SSDI or SSI income statements**
- **Income portion of FoodShare benefit statement**
- **Child support and/or alimony statements**
- **Latest tax return**
- **Proof of any other source of income (indicating dollar amount received)**

If you claim no income:

A letter (on agency letterhead) — from the health agency staffer or social-service case manager who referred you — stating that you have no income and no health insurance

- **A letter — from anyone who provides you with money to pay bills — stating that you have no income and no health insurance**

Pharmacy

Access offers medications to all our patients through a partnership with UW Health Pharmacy Services. Patients can access the UW Pharmacy at our Joyce & Marshall Erdman Clinic, William T. Evjue Clinic or the Wingra Family Medical Center regardless of which Access medical clinic serves as their health care home.

Access not only offers medications that patients can afford, but it takes extra care to provide the right information to patients so they understand their medications and how to use them. This ranges from using show-and-tell practices where patients see medications before leaving the pharmacy, to providing language-appropriate explanation, and verbal instruction for those who have trouble understanding written information.

Having direct access to a pharmacy helps patients get the prescriptions they need right away. Because we can offer more affordable medication, we can help patients achieve good health and better manage illness.

Payment Options

Sliding Fee Discount We offer medical, dental, and behavioral health services on a sliding scale. Patients may be asked to pay a minimum amount at the time of their appointment. Any remaining charges will be billed to the patient. Our staff will work with you to determine your eligibility for our sliding fee discount.

Medicaid and BadgerCare Both are accepted for medical, behavioral health and dental services at all of our clinics.

Medicare Medicare is accepted at our medical clinics.
