REMEMBER* NARCAN can save the life of someone who has overdosed on any opioid- (i.e. heroin. Prescription opioid medications can include hydrocodone, sold as Vicodin and Lortab, and oxycodone, sold as Percocet, as well as many others) and it is as harmless as giving someone an aspirin if you give it to someone- it will not harm them- it's better to err on the side of caution and administer it if you think this is why a person is unresponsive because of that. Signs of Opioid Overdose: Blue Lips, very slow or stopped breathing, will not wake when rubbing knuckles along sternum or across lips.**

1. **CALL 911 Immediately.**
2. **Administer NARCAN (1 CC in each bottle loaded into Syringe) by loading syringe and injecting either the buttocks or thigh.**
3. **Perform Rescue Breathing- 1 breath every 5 seconds**
4. **If they do not wake and are not breathing on their own, administer another dose after 2-3 Minutes.**
5. **If still not responsive, continue rescue breathing until EMS Arrives**
